- To be eligible for a scholarship in theatre, you must have at least a 3.0 overall high school or junior college grade point average.
- Applicants interested in performance (acting/directing) are required to perform a 2-4 minute audition. Those interested in design/technology will be expected to review their work in those areas.
- As part of your application materials, send a resumé detailing your high school and/or junior college theatrical activities and accomplishments – both on stage and backstage.
- Arrange to have a letter of recommendation from a theatre teacher with whom you have worked closely and your official high school or junior college transcript sent to the address above. If you have attended more than one high school or junior college, send official transcripts from each.
- List a theatre teacher and at least one other reference who may be contacted to discuss your background, experience, and accomplishments.
