B) **Transfer Students:** Have a recommendation sent directly to the Redwine Honors Program from a teacher or professor you had or currently have in college.

3. **Transfer Students:** Please submit a copy of any transcripts for course credit previously received through AP/IB exams, dual-enrollment, or other higher education institutions.

Applicants who have been awarded the Priddy Scholarship are not eligible to receive Redwine Honors Scholarship but may participate in the Honors program and all of its associated non-scholarship benefits.
