Enhancements to Library's Primo System

Moffett Library is pleased to announce that the new version of Primo, the library's one-stop searching tool, has been enhanced. The new functionality enables users to:

- Obtain relevant, personalized results. The Primo ScholarRank™ technology now tailors the relevance ranking of results to the user's discipline and academic degree. The ScholarRank appears the first time you sign into your Primo account.
- Refine search results. Features added to Primo faceted browsing enable users to include and exclude multiple facets and thereby rapidly hone in on the required information. The facets are located on the left side of the Primo window.
- Select exact date limits for searches by using the advanced search option.
- Save a result page for future use. In Primo 4, users can save an entire page of results in their e-shelf instead of saving them individually.
