## In the Spotlight

**Keith Williamson**, MSU Medical Director and Vinson Health Center physician, was named a Fellow of the American Academy of Family Physicians on January 17. Induction into the Fellowship is based on experience, demonstrated expertise, board exams, volunteer service, and leadership in the hospital and medical community.

Williamson has been the only physician at the Vinson Health Center for 22 years.

**Frank B. Wyatt**, Professor in the Department of Athletic Training and Exercise Physiology, was the sole author on a recent publication. The published work was "Physiological Responses to Altitude: A Brief Review" published in the *Journal of Exercise Physiology*, Volume 17 (1): 90-96.
