While connecting solidly with his Latino fans, Santiago is just as popular for his savvy mainstream material, reminiscent of George Carlin and Jerry Seinfeld. With the premiere of his first television special, "Comedy Central Presents: Bill Santiago," he won over fans nationwide with his dead-on observations about Spanglish – "twice the vocabulary, half the grammar!" and his beloved catchphrase "¡Porque Because!" This led to his first book, *Pardon My Spanglish. ¡Porque Because!* The book is now being used at universities and high schools across the country to stimulate discussions about identity, language and multiculturalism.
