2016-2017 Parking Permits on Sale

As a reminder, parking permits for academic year 2016-2017 are still on sale at www.permitsales.net/MWSU. This site is also accessible through the MSU PD main webpage. Using this portal, users may register vehicle(s), select a payment option, and arrange for the permit to be mailed a specific address. Once users have successfully completed the registration process, they will receive an email confirmation, as well as an email with a temporary parking permit for use while permanent permits are

mailed. (Note: The 2015-2016 parking permits are good through August 31, so users may not need the temporary permit). Please note that employees wishing to select the payroll deduction option should have completed their transaction prior to August 18.

Parking office personnel are on hand to answer any questions and provide help. The parking office is open Monday through Friday, during normal office hours at ext. 4310 or parking@mwsu.edu.
