In the Spotlight

Keith Williamson, MSU Medical Director, published an article in conjunction with researchers from the University of Connecticut and the University of Wyoming. Using pooled data collected at the Hotter'N Hell Hundred over three years, the article sheds light on the best hydration strategies and risks of water toxicity for men and women. "Endurance Cyclist Fluid Intake, Hydration Status, Thirst, and Thermal Sensations: Gender Differences" is available in the April issue of *International Journal of Sport Nutrition and Exercise Metabolism* published online at <http://journals.humankinetics.com/ijsem-current-issue>.
