**Jeff Killion**, Interim Dean for the Robert D & Carol Gunn College of Health Sciences & Human Services, was named president of the Texas Society of Allied Health Professions at the 40th Annual Conference September 21-22, hosted by the School of Allied Health Sciences, Baylor College of Medicine, in Houston, Texas.

**Andrew J. Allen**, Assistant Professor of Music, has had an article published in the October 2017 edition of *Teaching Music*, a journal of the National Association for Music Education. The article is titled "Stop the Pops: The Secrets of Saxophone Articulation."

**Yvonne Franke**, Assistant Professor of German, presented the paper "Die Entwicklung der Komödie von Lessing bis Bernhard" at the recent South Central Modern Language Association (SCMLA) conference in Tulsa, Okla.

The **Wichita Falls Museum of Art at Midwestern State University** is a recipient of an Arts Create grant from the Texas Commission on the Arts. An Arts Create grant provides support to Texas arts organizations with budgets over \$50,000. For fiscal year 2018 the TCA has approved Arts Create funding of 378 grants totaling more than \$3 million to museums in 75 Texas cities. The grant will partially support exhibitions at the WFMA in the 2017-2018 schedule. The WFMA will present a major exhibition of original prints from Flat Bed Press of Austin, Texas. In summer 2018, the WFMA will present a major exhibition from the Williford Foundation Collection of 19th century paintings by American expatriate artists in Italy, including artworks by such luminaries as William Merritt Chase, Elihu Vedder, Frank Duveneck, and Charles Cary Coleman.
