



## **PD.EDUCATION Student User Guide Midwestern State University**

### **Introduction**

Thanks to the Association of Texas Graduate Schools (ATGS), graduate students of MSU Texas have been given free access to pd.education, which provides professional development services for graduate-level students. You can access pd.education via the link below or by downloading the pd.education app in the App Store or Google Play.

### **Login**

You can access pd.education by following this link: <https://pd.education/atgs-login.html>  
The username is **atgs.msutexas**, and the password is **#123Msutexas#**.

### **Home**

As you scroll down the home page, you will find the main topics covered on the website. Each topic has webinars, articles, downloads, self-assessments, and/or learning modules. At the bottom of the home page, upcoming events are listed. When navigating the website, you can return to the home page at any time via the "Home" button in the top menu.

### **Webinars**

In the top menu, hover over "Webinars" and select the webinars library to browse webinars by topic. Also under "Webinars" you can select the webinar calendar to view and download the calendar as a PDF.

### **Courses**

In the top menu, hover over "Courses" to select short courses or directed learning modules.

### **Resources**

In the top menu, hover over "Resources" and select "Box Sets" to choose a topic and view all the videos for that topic in one place. Also under "Resources" you can select the Downloads Center to view important and useful documents by topic and download the ones you need.

### **My PD Zone**

**NOTE: All graduate students of MSU Texas log into the same pd.education account with the same credentials; therefore, making changes to the account is not allowed.**

When you click on "My PD Zone" you will find the personal professional development plan, the doctoral milestone checklist, help with self-assessing your research, and challenges calendars. Also, upcoming webinars are listed, and you can search for content by keyword, topic, or phase.
