 - An IB diploma
 - In special cases, other relevant outstanding achievements

Academic Scholarships

Honors students are eligible for one of two academic scholarships: the Redwine Honors Scholarship and the Redwine Honors Presidential Scholarship.

Redwine Honors Scholarship:

The Redwine Honors Scholarship is awarded to students of all classifications in amounts up to \$4,000 per academic year, is renewable for up to four years (or 8 semesters), and requires admission to the Honors Program; for eligibility requirements, see the top of the first page. To be considered for scholarship funding for the fall semester, applications must be received or postmarked by January 15th.

Redwine Honors Presidential Scholarship:

Redwine Honors Presidential Scholarship is awarded to five distinguished *incoming high school graduates only* in the amount of \$10,000 per academic year beginning each fall. This scholarship is renewable for up to four years and requires admission to the Honors Program. Recipients must maintain a 3.50 GPA, enroll in a minimum of 15 credit hours each long semester (see above), and complete additional honors program requirements. To be considered for scholarship funding for the fall semester, applications must be received or postmarked by January 15th.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Applicants must be unconditionally accepted for admission to Midwestern State University.
2. Applicants must be incoming freshmen.
3. Applicant must be in the top 15% of their graduating class.
4. Applicants must meet one of the following:
 - A minimum combined SAT score of 1270, excluding writing
 - A minimum combined ACT score of 27, excluding writing

PLEASE NOTE: Recipients of the Redwine Honors Scholarship and the Redwine Honors Presidential Scholarship must be enrolled in a minimum of fifteen (15) semester hours per long term, passing a minimum of thirty (30) semester hours prior to the beginning of the next academic year. Additionally, applicants who have been awarded the Priddy Scholarship are not eligible to receive Redwine Honors or Redwine Honors Presidential Scholarships but may participate in the Redwine Honors Program and receive the benefits of all of its associated non-scholarship privileges and perks.
