

Application for the Phil Colee Memorial Scholarship for Spring 2023

The Midwestern State University Department of Sociology is now accepting applications from undergraduate sociology majors for the Phil Colee Memorial Scholarship.

The Phil Colee Scholarship was established as a memorial to Dr. Phil Colee, a former professor of Anthropology at Midwestern. Dr. Colee is remembered for the many anthropological field trips he took with students, demonstrating the true spirit of discovery, undergraduate research, and commitment to his students. He taught for 20 years at MSU and inspired many students. He was an outstanding colleague. We honor him and his family with this scholarship.

We anticipate awarding two Colee scholarships, each in the amount of about \$500.00 for the spring 2022 academic year.

Scholarship recipients will be selected by the faculty of the Midwestern State University Sociology Program. To be eligible to receive one of the Colee Scholarships, the student must meet these minimum qualifications during each semester in which the scholarship is received:

- The student must be a sociology major at Midwestern State University.
- The student must be a junior or senior (i.e., 60 or more credit hours completed by the end of the current semester).
- The student must show a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
- The student must show a 3.0 grade point average in sociology courses.
- The student must maintain enrollment in at least 12 credit hours at Midwestern, including at least one course in sociology, during each semester in which the scholarship is received.

Applications for the Phil Colee Memorial Scholarship are taken for either a fall or spring semester. Current scholarship recipients must reapply to be considered in subsequent years. The Phil Colee Memorial Scholarship is awarded for an entire academic year, but is paid in the fall or spring semester.
