Texas Tech University System

Effective September 1, 2021, Midwestern State University officially becomes the fifth university to join the Texas Tech System. Joining the Texas Tech System means that MSU Texas will now share a common Board of Regents with the other four institutions in the system. Additionally, there will be a few other shared services among the institutions in the system but MSU Texas will maintain its identity, campus leadership, and programs. The institutions that are part of the TTU System now include:

- Texas Tech University
- Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center
- Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center-El Paso
- Angelo State University
- Midwestern State University

The Texas Tech University System collectively has approximately 57,000 students, 21 academic locations in 18 cities and more than 300,000 alumni. As we move through the academic year, you will begin to see "Member of the Texas Tech University System" on a variety of different marketing pieces.

New Programs at MSU Texas

MSU Texas has developed a number of new programs over the last year that we are excited to share with you. The McCoy College of Science Math and Engineering has created a five (5) year BS to MS program in Computer Science that is effective fall 2021. Additionally, in fall 2021 is the rollout of the MSU Texas SAE Formula Racecar team. This is an exciting cross-disciplinary, hands-on, and fun way for STEAM students to apply their knowledge within the McCoy College.

Effective fall 2022, MSU Texas will have an Industrial Technology major available for students that includes a computer science minor. This major is similar to engineering however, rather than focusing on design, the Industrial Technology major will focus on industrial safety and manufacturing. The Fain College of Fine Arts also has a new major effective fall 2022 in Musical Theatre that will allow students to study the combination of song and spoken dialogue with performance.

In addition to new majors at MSU Texas, there are also a variety of unique minors that students can combine with their major to help give them an edge in the marketplace.
