The SPIRIT Award stands for Service, Pride, Initiative, Responsibility, Integrity, and Teamwork and is awarded to individuals or groups in recognition of their support of Midwestern State University.

Established in 1996, the first honorees were the MSU Kiowa Kooks who have contributed countless hours of service for the benefit of Midwestern and the Alumni Association. The award is presented each year during Homecoming at the Alumni Awards Ceremony.

SELECTION

Recipients must meet the criteria below to be considered for the SPIRIT Award.

CRITERIA

Recipients must have graduated with an undergraduate or a graduate degree from Midwestern State University and be heavily involved with MSU Texas with their time, treasure or talent. This person should be synonymous with Midwestern State University.

Nominations must include the nominee's activities, achievements, and contributions qualifying them for the Spirit Award.
