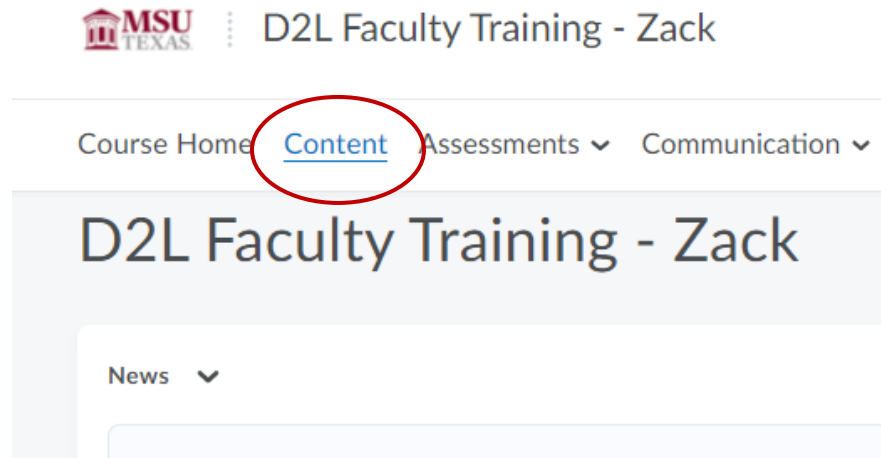


Add Video or Audio

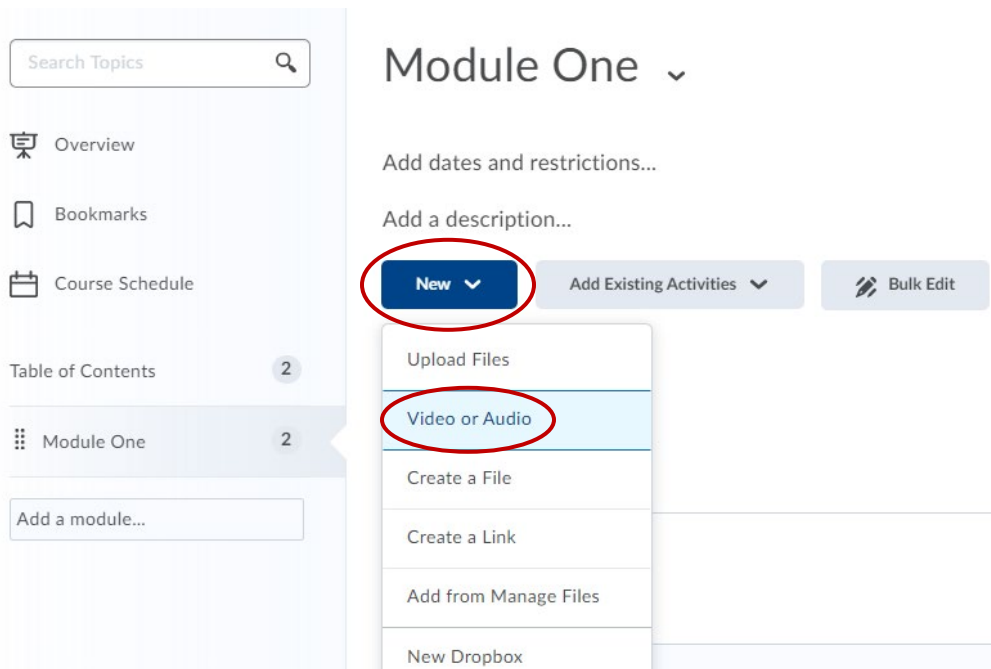
Step 1:

From your course homepage, click on **Content**.




Step 2:

Navigate to the Module where you want to add the video or audio. Select **New**, then select **Video or Audio**.




Step 3a:

From here, you can add a web URL or embed code, or you can upload your own.

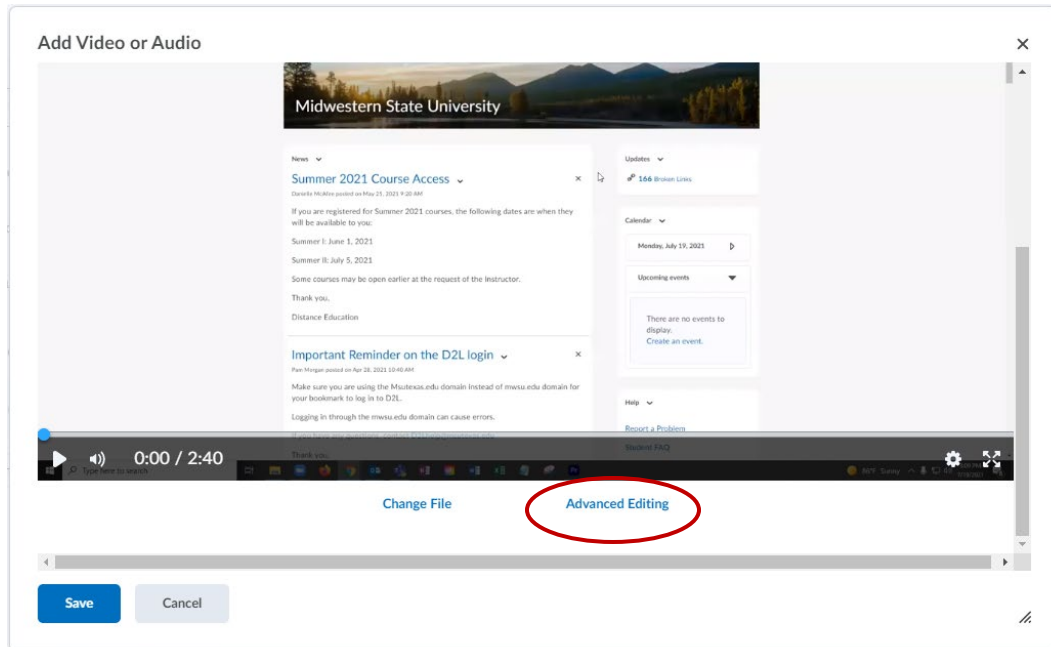
