



Grading a Discussion Topic

You can grade a Discussion Topic directly from the Discussion Tool. Please note, you will only be able to grade if you have set up the grade item under the assessment tab in the discussion settings.

1. Navigate to the Discussions Tool by clicking Communication and selecting Discussions.
2. Next to the Topic you want to grade, click the down arrow for the context menu and select Assess Topic.
