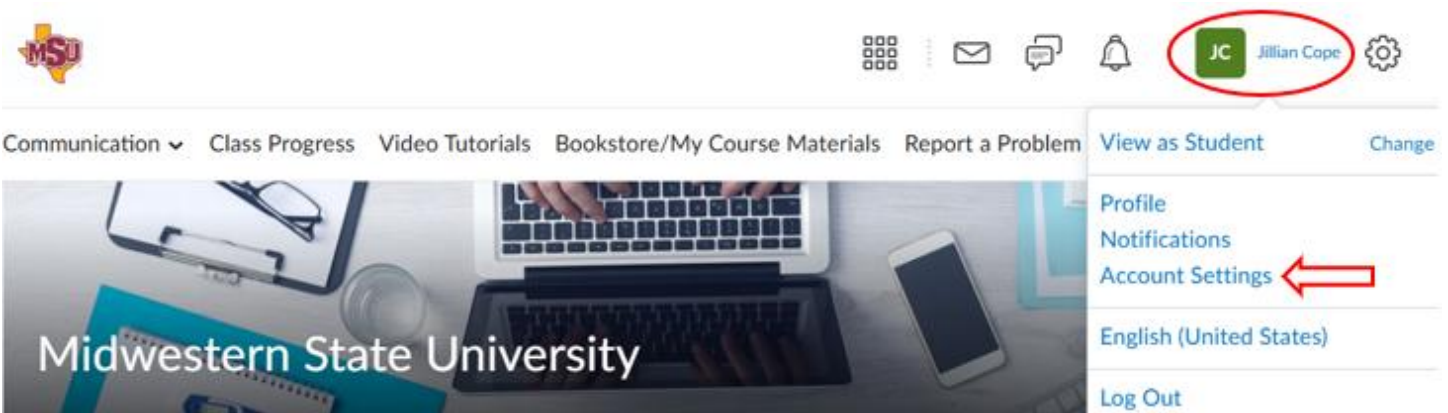

Application Settings

Applications registered to your account can access the system on your behalf.

Display:

The **Display** section gives you six settings you can change to control how your email inbox is displayed.

Display Options

- Show the Message Preview pane
- Show the Folder List pane
- Mark messages as read when viewed in the Message Preview pane
- Show internal email addresses in the Address Book
- Show external email addresses in the Address Book
- Allow filtering messages and contacts on group enrollment

Forwarding:

The **Forwarding Options** section allows you to forward all of your D2L emails to your personal email account. You can also tell it to delete, mark unread or mark read after it's been forwarded.
