

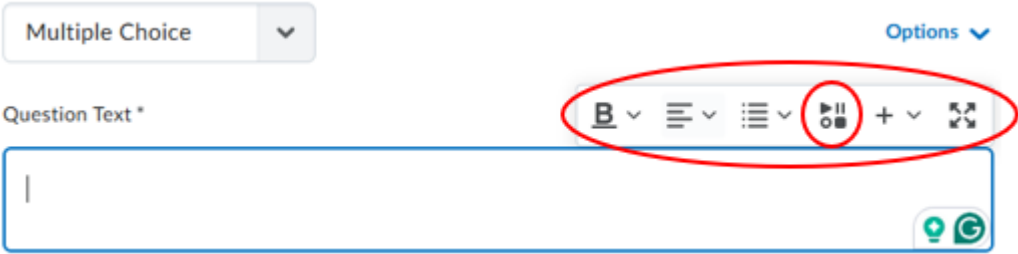


Inserting Images into a Quiz Question

Workflow Steps:

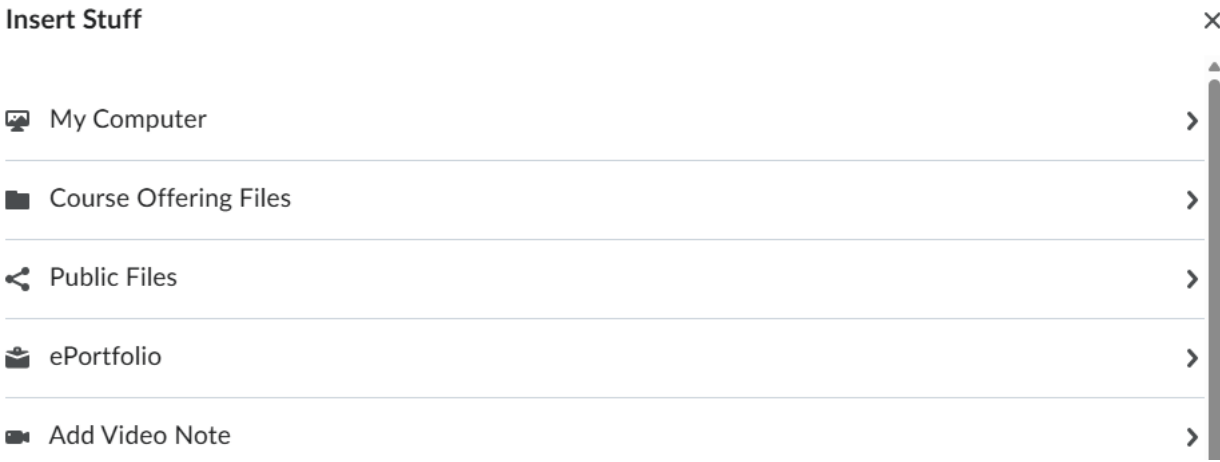
Step one:

When creating a new question, you can add an image to the text. Click in the text box and a menu bar will populate. Select the **Insert Stuff** icon.



Step two:

The **Insert Stuff** menu will appear, offering several options for uploading an image. It is best practice to have the image saved to your computer beforehand.




Step three:

From here, you can upload an image by selecting **Upload**, or drag and drop a file directly into the upload area. Once you have uploaded the file, select **Upload**.

Step four:

For accessibility, you may need to add **Alternate Text** for the image so it can be read by screen readers. Provide a description that does not reveal the answer. If the image is purely **decorative**, you can mark it as such instead. Once complete, select **Insert**.
