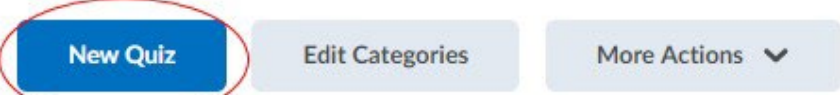
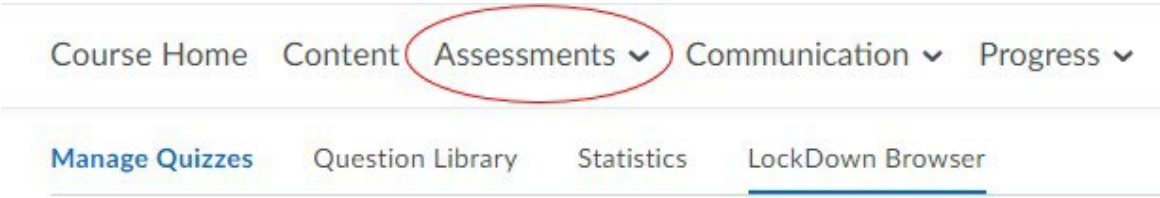




# Randomize a Test using a Question Pool

This method is a recommended best practice for maintaining test integrity. If you have 100 questions that you can use for a test, it is possible to use this function to pull 25 random questions from it in order for your students to get different tests.

- 1. Navigate to the Quiz tool via Assessments -> Tests.
- 2. Create New Quiz or select an existing quiz to edit. You must have existing questions in the Question Library for this process.



- 3. Give the quiz a name if it doesn't have one and Create New.





4. Click Question pool.
