## North Texas Chapter of the Texas Association of Vietnam Veterans Scholarship

The North Texas Chapter of the Texas Association of Vietnam Veterans Scholarship at Midwestern State University is a \$1,000 scholarship (\$500 per semester for two consecutive semesters) awarded to a student who attends or will attend MSU. The scholarship will be added to the student's account in the MSU Business Office. Academic achievement, good citizenship and financial need will be considered.

- 1. The recipient must be a Vietnam veteran or a child, grandchild, or spouse of a Vietnam veteran. A Vietnam veteran will be defined as a veteran who served in Vietnam, Thailand, Cambodia, Laos, or in the waters off the coast of these countries, who was awarded the Vietnam Service Medal which can be verified by the veteran's DD214.
- 2. The recipient must be a full-time student at MSU and maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5.
- 3. The scholarship is for one year only. Scholarship recipients must reapply to be considered in subsequent years.
- 4. Application must be accompanied by the following:
  - -A copy of the applicant's or veteran's DD114 and,
  - -An official college transcript (current students) or a high school transcript (beginning freshmen) and,
    - -A copy of the marriage license if applicant is the spouse of a Vietnam veteran or,
    - -A copy of the birth certificate showing hereditary lineage to a Vietnam Veteran.

The recipient will be selected by the North Texas Chapter of the Texas Association of Vietnam Veterans scholarship committee. All decisions made by the committee are final.
