Recommended Resources

CINAHL Complete (Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health)

Provides full text and indexing for journals from the fields of nursing, biomedicine, alternative/complementary medicine, consumer health and allied health disciplines. In addition, this database offers access to health care books, nursing dissertations, selected conference proceedings, standards of practice, educational software, audiovisuals and book chapters.

Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition

Provides scholarly full text journals, focusing on many medical disciplines as far back as 1975.

MEDLINE Complete

Offers access to information from all journals indexed in the National Library of Medicine's MEDLINE file. Provides authoritative medical information on medicine, nursing, dentistry, veterinary medicine, the health care system pre-clinical services, and much more.

PSYCINFO

Contains citations and summaries of journal articles, (some full text) book chapters, books, technical reports, and dissertations in the field of psychology and psychological aspects of related disciplines, such as medicine, psychiatry, nursing, social work, education, pharmacology, physiology, linguistics, anthropology, business, and law from 1887- present.

Other Resources

Academic Search Complete

Database of peer-reviewed academic journals contains full-text articles, abstracts, and indexing from scholarly publications. The journals offered cover such areas as social sciences, humanities, education, computer sciences, and engineering.

BioONE

Database of full-text articles from a variety of biology journals, with a stronger focus on zoology, ecology, and environmental sciences. Most journals in this collection are published by small scientific societies and non-commercial publishers. (Includes BioOne parts 1 and 2)

Medica Latina

Spanish language medical research and investigative journals published by renowned Latin American medical publishers.

CDC Wonder

Wide-ranging Online Data for Epidemiologic Research (WONDER)—is an easy-to-use internet system that makes the information resources of the Center for Disease Control (CDC) available to public health professionals and the public at large. It provides access to a wide array of public health information.

Psychology & Behavioral Sciences Collection

Comprehensive database covering topics such as emotional and behavioral characteristics, psychiatry & psychology, mental processes, anthropology, and observational and experimental methods.

Cochrane

The Cochrane Library is a collection of databases that contain high-quality, independent evidence to inform healthcare decision making. Cochrane Reviews represent the highest level of evidence on which to base clinical treatment decisions.

ScienceDirect College Edition

This is a database that contains over 2000 full-text peer reviewed journals. The journals cover behavioral & social sciences, health & life sciences, and physical sciences from 1995 - present.

Health Reference Center Academic

Full service resource for health related research. It provides an integrated collection of general interest health and fitness magazines, medical and professional periodicals, reference books and pamphlets.

WorldCat

Bibliographic records for books, manuscripts, computer data files, maps, computer programs, musical scores, films and slides, newspapers, journals, sound recordings, magazines, videotapes. This powerful database searches the collections of all the member libraries of OCLC. A direct link to the Interlibrary Loan system makes it easy to check on availability and order items that are not available in our collection.
