I. Policy Statement and Purpose

Midwestern State University ("MSU" or "University"), a component institution of the Texas Tech University ("TTU") System, is committed to the safety of its campus community and to complying with the requirements of the Stop Campus Hazing Act - Public Law 118-173 - passed by the 118th Congress of the United States and signed into law on December 23, 2024.

II. Governing Policy

The University's policies and procedures to comply with the requirements of the Stop Campus Hazing Act are governed by <u>TTU System Regulation 07.19</u>: <u>Stop Campus Hazing Act Compliance</u>.

IV. Related Statutes, Rules, Regulations, Policies, and Resources

Public Law 118-17318 (Otherwise known as the "Stop Campus Hazing Act," which amended the *Jeanne Clery Campus Safety Act* (Clery Act), § 485(f) of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended ("HEA") requiring institutions of higher education that participate in federal financial assistance programs authorized under Title IV of the HEA to comply with certain policy, disclosure, and prevention requirements related to hazing involving student organizations.)

<u>Texas Education Code §51.936(c-1)</u> (Requiring postsecondary educational institutions to publish, in a prominent location on its website, a report on hazing committed on or off campus by an organization registered with or recognized by the institution.)
