

# What To Pack

## Residence Life & Housing

### The Essentials

- Clothing and hangers
- Personal grooming products
- Bedding and room décor\*
- Towels and shower caddy
- Laundry detergent and laundry basket
- Trash can
- Personal fan
- Phone charger
- Three cloth face coverings
- Thermometer, hand sanitizer, & wipes
- Medications (including fever reducers)

### Suggested Items

- Television & coaxial cable
- Gaming systems
- Bicycle and lock
- Computer, printer
- Power strip with a surge protector
- Desk lamp
- Small bulletin board
- Dishes and eating utensils

### What Not to Bring

- Halogen lamps and bulbs
- Candles
- Pets (other than small fish)
- Bleach
- Decorative string lights (unless battery operated)
- Routers
- Appliances with heating elements
- Air conditioners

## \*Other Details

**Bedding:** Legacy Hall has extra-long, twin beds. Killingsworth and McCullough-Trigg have standard twin beds. Mattresses in Sundance Court and Sunwatcher Village are full-size. Be sure to bring sheets, bedspreads or blankets, and a pillow.

**Hanging Room Décor:** Double sided poster tape and 3M strips have been shown to damage walls in the residence halls. We recommend using painter's tape to secure lightweight items (posters, photos, etc.) to walls.

**Internet & Computer Access:** Upon arrival, students will register devices on the ResNet system. This system provides you access to the Internet and digital cable. A computer lab with printing capabilities is located in Legacy Hall's Market Street Learning Commons.

**Appliances:** A MicroFridge® (combination refrigerator, freezer, microwave unit) approved by the University is provided in every residence hall room. Appliances prohibited in the residence halls include: hot plate, toaster, crockpot, toaster oven, lava lamps, rice cookers, electric frying pans, air fryer, deep fryer, kettles, air conditioners, and space heaters.

**Room Fresheners:** We recognize each person may have different levels of tolerance for smells in a room. Scentsy and other types of room fresheners are permitted, provided all occupants in the room approve of use. Candles and incense are not permitted.
