- 1. Refer to the program's Curriculum Map to align assessment measures with the correct SLO.
- 2. Enter a description of the assessment measure, which should include:
 - a. Mode of assessment (e.g., entrance/exit exam, portfolio, essay, etc.)
 - b. Scoring system (e.g., 4 point rubric, 1=Emerging, 2=Approaching, 3=Proficient, etc.)
 - c. Other relevant details (e.g., specific exam section, example questions, etc.).
- 3. Indicate the measure type (Direct or Indirect)
- 4. Indicate which populations or courses will be assessed (e.g., all entering first years/all graduating seniors, all students within ENGL 1143, etc.).
- 5. Indicate the frequency of which the assessment will occur (e.g., every Fall, every two years, etc.)
