

Curriculum Map Instructions

1. Enter the Student Learning Outcomes for the program into the empty boxes at the top of the page.
2. In the next table, enter in the program-specific degree requirements for the program. This should not include Core courses unless the major requires that students take a specific one.
3. For each degree requirement listed, indicate with which SLOs it is aligned by placing an X in the corresponding box. This can also be customized to the needs of the program. For example, programs can split alignment with SLOs into different levels (e.g. I=Introduced, E=Expanded, A=Accomplished).
4. If the program chooses to customize how alignment is indicated, explain the system using the blank box at the bottom of the mapping table.
