Student Safety

Your student's safety is our priority. As a result, MSU Texas has many measures in place to make our campus community safe and secure:

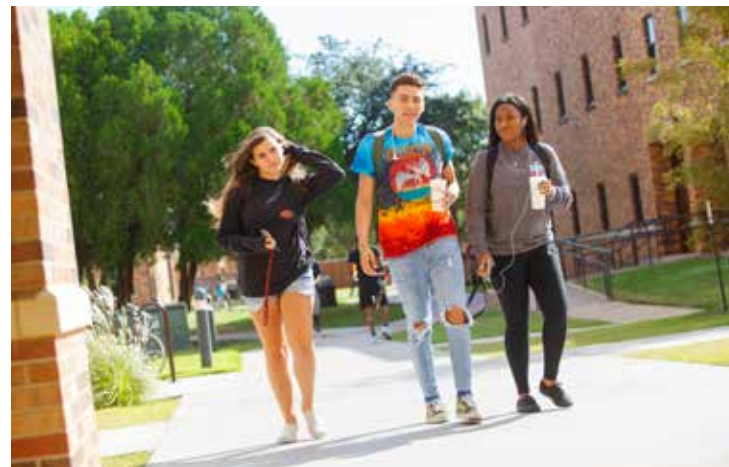
- 10 full-time sworn police officers with 24/7 patrol
- Multiple blue-light phones located strategically throughout campus that connect directly with campus police
- Security escorts for any student traveling across campus at night.

Orientation

All new students at MSU Texas are required to participate in orientation. Your student will become better acquainted with the MSU campus and learn more of the resources available to them. Attendance at orientation will help your child become more self-reliant as they become more comfortable with campus and more confident in their ability to succeed at college. Financial Aid

At MSU Texas, students can receive a quality education without the heavy debt so common at other universities. Last year 79% of MSU Texas students received financial aid assistance and over \$2 million in scholarship funds. Have your student complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [FAFSA.ed.gov](https://fafsa.ed.gov) beginning October 1. The MSU FAFSA Code is 003592.

Tuition Payment Planning

At MSU, we understand that the cost of college means planning for those additional expenses. We have options to help:

- Tuition Installment Plans – allows you or your student to pay your tuition bill in three separate payments (two in the summer terms) instead of all at once.
- Emergency Tuition and Fee Loan – a short-term loan that allows your student to defer tuition and fee expenses to later in the semester until their aid has arrived.

Mustangs Guarantee

MSU Texas understands that regardless of how affordable MSU may be, tuition of any amount may be too much for some families. In order to help, MSU has created the Mustangs Guarantee Program specifically for Texas families whose adjusted gross income is \$65,000 or less and who are Pell Grant eligible.
