RE: RFP 735-2023-4388 Redwine Chiller Replacement Project

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN,

Please see the response to the question submitted below:

- 1. The existing chiller schedule is laid out on Trane. The existing chillers are Carrier Aqua Snap Chillers. Does Owner have a preference of what brand is installed? Trane, Carrier, Daikin, York
- 2. Please confirm that existing controls is BacNet and Provide Information on who is proprietary on the controls system at this building? Yes controls is BacNet; Andover is proprietary
- 3. Can you confirm if intergrading the new Communication Card to Existing Controls is part of this contract or will that be done by Owner after project Completion? As long as it is BacNet compatible, MSU will have it integrated by Entech at our cost.
- 4. There is not a specific wage classification for HVAC Technician, Can you please confirm that HVAC on this project will be classified as Pipefitter Journeyman? Yes. For this project please use Pipefitter Journeyman.
- 5. Please confirm no permits are required from the City for Replacement of these chillers? We are on State property so City permits are not required. We are on State property so City permits are not required.
- 6. 15629_1.4_B talks about shop drawings. Can you please confirm this is for chiller only and that construction "Drawings" will be not be required for replacement? Chiller only drawings are required, not construction drawings.
- 7. Specifications call for R134a on Refrigerant however R410a is existing. Can you please confirm Required Refrigerant Spec? R410a is acceptable.
- 8. 15629_2.1_J_5 speaks of a Field Power Disconnect. However existing only has disconnect integral to the chiller. Can you confirm if Additional Non-Fused Disconnect is required per specifications? No. In field disconnect is not required
- 9. Please confirm that all Notes on As-Build Chiller Schedule are Required for New Chillers? Yes, as a minimum.
- 10. Please confirm that Nominal 150 ton Chillers are Required and not 130 Tons per existing chiller schedule? 150 ton chillers are required, **NOT** 130 ton that appears on the schedule.

- 11. There is no mention of replacing the existing 2-way controls vales at each chiller. Please confirm existing valves stay in place? Existing 2-way valves stay in place
- 12. Please confirm that we are only to demo required piping to replace chillers or is all piping exterior to be replaced? Only demo required piping to make your equipment operate. It is not necessary to demo all of the exterior piping, unless you abandon part of it.
- 13. Please confirm existing butterfly valves are not to be replaced? Existing butterfly valves are not replaced.
- 14. Per 735-2024-4388-Chiller-replacement-project.pdf, Section 6.1 Response Requirements, you check off you want Performance bond with the response; but that is provided after award. It may be provided after award.
- 15. Per Appendix G, Wage Rates, it does not list any HVAC Mechanic/positions, rates. Please advise. Yes. For this project please use Pipefitter Journeyman.
- 16. Please verify like in kind of the Existing Chillers or Equal too Existing as the M-502 Chiller Schedule Trane Model Number Referenced differs from the Spec and what is installed. Like in kind of existing chillers is required, not the M-502 chiller schedule
